





Community Outreach




Last month Meg Jenkins represented us at Women Fly, an educational conference held at the Museum of Flight at Boeing Field in Seattle, Washington. This program aims at opening the eyes of disadvantaged girls about what might be possible in aviation as they look to enter the workforce. Meg was asked to speak on a panel about career skills and represented the airport well.

Anna Valsing, Meg Jenkins, and Tony Cross attended the Wyoming Workforce Services Career Expo at the Jackson Hole High School. The breakout session put on by the airport was so popular, they were asked to speak to a second group of students as well. Meg and Anna gave a presentation on the variety of career options available in the aviation industry. Anna is a former graduate of the high school and shared her career path to working at JAC, (including getting a pilot's license at 17).


Upcoming Events
