

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING
GENERAL OPERATING RULES
Jackson Hole Airport Board
September 18, 2019

BACKGROUND: The Jackson Hole Airport Board (the "Board") operates the Jackson Hole Airport (the "Airport"), which is a public airport located in Teton County, Wyoming. The Airport operates in Grand Teton National Park under an Agreement with the United States Department of the Interior.

The Airport serves both airline and general aviation aircraft and contains areas such as the runway, taxiway and ramp on which aircraft operate. The Airport also contains other areas upon which motor vehicles operate, including those dropping off and picking up passengers. Because the Airport is public, it accommodates certain speech and assembly activities which are protected under the First Amendment.

PROPOSED RULES: The Board proposes to adopt General Operating Rules to collect and formalize a number of existing policies, and in some cases to address areas for which no formal policies now exist. These include proposed rules related to (a) aircraft operations, (b) aircraft accidents, (c) materials storage and handling, including glycol, (c) fueling and fuel storage, including the exercise of an exclusive right to store aviation fuel, (d) aircraft maintenance, (e) motor vehicle operation and parking, (f) airport security and restricted areas, (g) the accommodation of First Amendment activity, (h) protection of the Airport environment, and (i) smoking.

COMMENTS: The Airport Board solicits comments (including the submission of data, views or arguments) on the proposed rules. Written comments and opinions should be submitted no later than **November 15, 2019**. They should be addressed to:
