WHEREAS, Senator Coe served 32 years in Wyoming legislation, dedicating himself to serving Wyoming residents as Senate Vice President, Majority Floor Leader and President and;

WHEREAS, sitting as chair for the Air Transportation Liaison Committee among many other committees that worked to support economic development and business and;

WHEREAS, while on the Air Transportation Liaison Committee, Senator Coe sponsored many bills to encourage grants and funding, as well as increase ridership of commercial airports and;
